### Financial Assistance

Basic Eligibility Guidelines for Emergency Financial Assistance

- Montgomery County Resident
- Eighteen years of age
- Applicant must apply in person and submit the following documentations:
- Photo ID
- Social Security cards and birth dates for all household members
- Income verification or means of support for all household members ( must provide pay stubs for the last six weeks, support letter, SSA/SSI, determination letter, unemployment letter. Etc..)
- Current eviction notice indicating amount needed
- Utilities disconnection notice (unable to assist if the shut of date is for today)
- Income available to meet future payments
- Financial assistance must resolve the emergency
- Applicants who have received financial assistance within the last twelve months are not eligible
